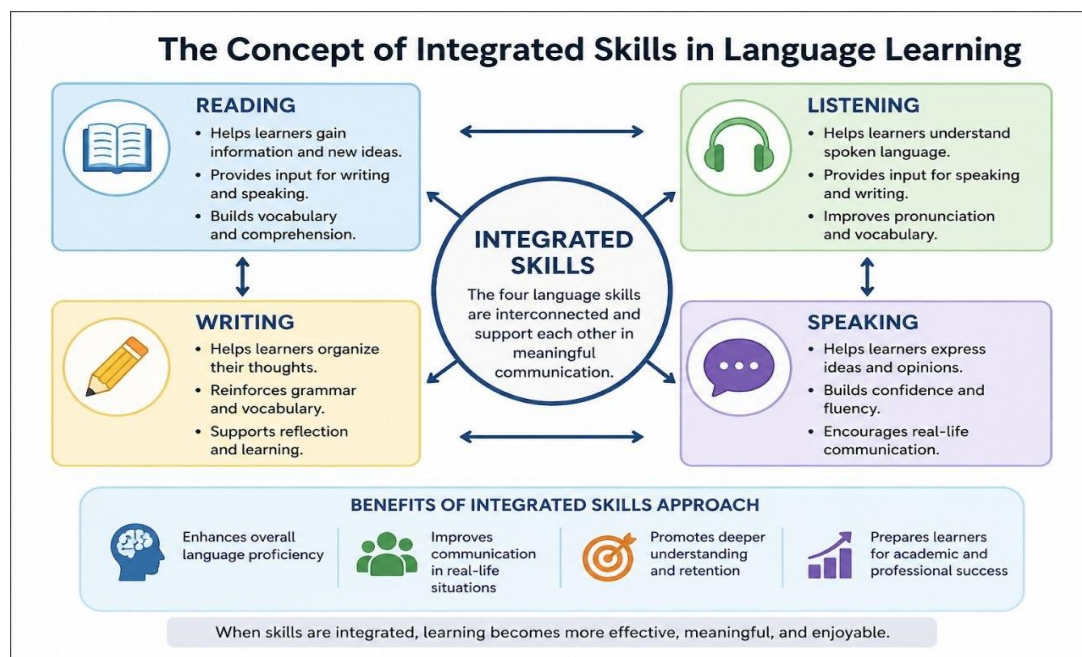

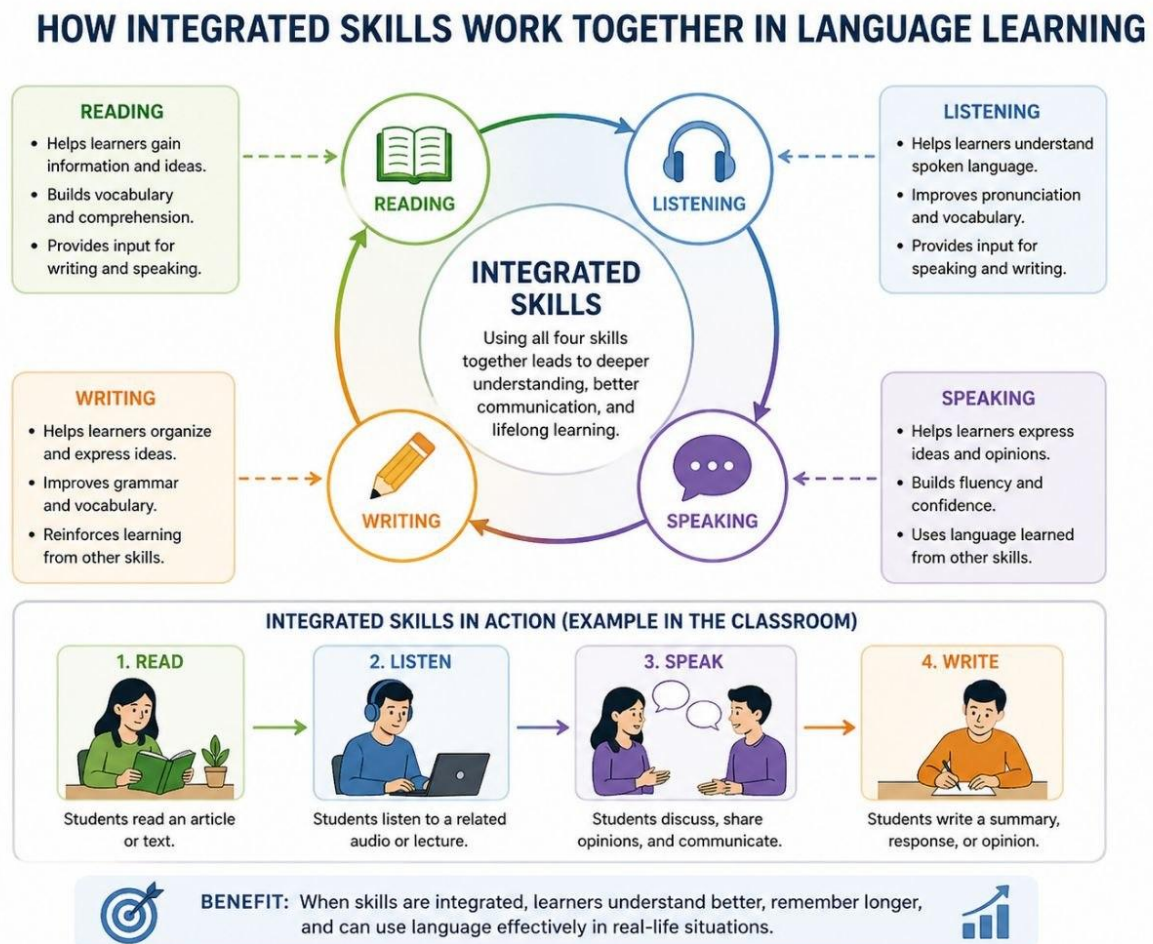
**Figure 1. The Concept of Integrated Skills in Language Learning**

**The concept of integrated skills is illustrated in Figure 1.**
